Who Should Attend: Engineers, landscape architects, landscape designers, landscapers, municipal staff, consultants, contractors, horticulturalists, businesses and industry representatives, master gardeners, students, and interested homeowners.

Topics covered: Rainwater harvesting systems will be discussed, going beyond rain barrels. Above ground tanks and below ground system design, installation and maintenance will be presented along with landscape features that utilize harvested rainwater. Locating rainwater harvesting systems is addressed as well as all of the appurtenances associated with such systems such as pumps, piping and gauges. Case studies will highlight installations in Iowa.

Rainscaping Iowa: A statewide education, training and certification program for those interested in and currently working to protect water quality and reduce the impacts of future floods.

Rainscaper: A certified individual that has met training, exam and design and/or installation requirements for specific Rainscaping practices. To become a Rainscaper one must attend training sessions for specific practices and pass a written exam at the conclusion of each training program. Case studies of practices must then be submitted for approval to become a Certified **Rainscaper**. The applicant must specify if they want recognition as a Designer, Installer or both Designer and Installer of the Rainscaping practice.

Rainscaper Trainers: **James Grizzard**, Rainscaping Iowa Consultant, has been involved in the design and installation of rainwater harvesting systems in Texas. He brings his vast knowledge and experience to Iowa. **Pat Sauer**, ISWEP, organizes Rainscaping training programs statewide. She focuses on the water quality aspects of rainwater harvesting systems.
